



## Deer Resistant Annuals

---



The plants deer prefer to eat vary from region to region and can even change seasonally. **NO PLANT IS DEER PROOF!** When hungry, deer will eat anything to survive. During stressful times such as drought, plants that are usually avoided may be damaged.

**Over fertilized and over watered plants are particularly lush and appealing to deer.**

The following annuals are *rarely* bothered by deer:
