
Red Robin Tomatoes

A simple guide to growing this popular variety of tomatoes



Red Robin tomatoes are a dwarf variety that bears sweet cherry-sized fruit. These tomatoes can be grown both indoors and outdoors, depending on the season. They're perfect for sunny windowsills, patios, and hanging baskets. When grown indoors, Red Robin will bear fruit year-round and can live in the same pot for up to 2 years.

Size:

8" - 12" tall and wide

Fruit:

1 1/4" sweet red fruit

Sun:

Full sun outdoors; Sunny windowsill indoors, preferably in a south or west-facing window.

Water:

Evenly moist soil; water thoroughly when top 1/3 of the soil surface has dried.

Fertilizer:

Feed mature potted plants twice monthly during the active growing season using a bloom-boosting fertilizer. You might try Age Old Organics Bloom. Supplement with Cali-Bur as needed.

For outdoor plants, you can apply kelp when transplanting into a bed or container. Follow with Age Old Grow for one month, finishing the season with Age Old Bloom.
