

Why Use Humic Acid?



- Humic Acid helps aerate soil.
- It activates the decomposition of plowed remains underneath crops, new compost, and grass clippings.
- Humic acid retains water soluble inorganic fertilizers and releases them to plants as needed.
- It's a natural compost and supplement to crop rotation, and it inoculates soil with microorganisms.
- Humic acid increases the water holding capacity of the soil.
- It improves soil texture and workability, and reduces soil erosion.
