Safety Notice

Your safety is our top priority! We kindly ask that all pets remain indoors while our team is working in your yard. Additionally, we will request locates for any gas or electric lines prior to scheduling your planting service. We will contact you once locates of gas and electric lines have been requested to arrange your planting appointment.

Important Note: Please ensure that all pet feces is picked up prior to your planting appointment. If our crew encounters pet feces and must remove it, an additional fee of \$30 will be added to your planting fee.

Planting and Material Fees

- Minimum Trip Fee: \$200 (jobs under \$200 will incur the minimum fee).
- Distance Note: Our planting services are available within 10 driven miles of Tagawa Garden Center. For services beyond this range, a fee of \$5/mile will apply.

What's Included?

When you choose our planting service, you receive:

- Mulching: Fresh, shredded western cedar mulch will be applied to retain moisture and suppress weeds around the planting.

- Soil Amendments: We include high-quality compost and Bio-tone, a plant starter infused with mycorrhizae to promote healthy growth.

Benefits of Mycorrhizae: Mycorrhizae are beneficial fungi that create symbiotic relationships with plant roots. Here's how they elevate your garden's health:

- Enhanced Nutrient Uptake: Increased root surface area allows for better absorption of water and essential nutrients.
 - Improved Soil Structure: Mycorrhizae bind soil particles, enhancing aeration and water retention for robust root systems.
 - Disease Resistance: They help protect plants from pathogens by competing for resources.
 - Stress Tolerance: Mycorrhizal plants are more resilient to drought and other environmental stresses.
- Staking: Our team will stake your trees with two sturdy metal T-posts if location requires. (CSU Extension advises staking trees only when necessary to protect the root ball from shifting in high winds, as over-staking can inhibit growth and weaken the tree) Tree stakes should be removed after the first full growing season in the ground.

*Wooden stakes are available for an additional charge upon request (**\$12.99+TAX/stake**).*

Tree Trunk Protector

*Trees in lawn areas are great, but mowing and weed whacking around your tree is not. We offer a corrugated tube to help protect your tree from accidental run ins with these power tools. **\$8.99+TAX/tree**.*

Scheduling Your Planting Service

Getting started is simple! After your purchase, we will promptly request locates for any gas or electric lines. Expect a call from us within 3 business days to confirm that locates have been requested and to schedule your planting service.

- **Flexible Appointments:** We can arrange appointments for times when you are not at home, so long as planting locations are clearly marked.
- **Placing Locator Flags:** We will give 1 flag per plant for you to place in your garden bed with the plant's name on it. This way we can plant even if you cannot be there.
- **Please note:** Once your tree planting is scheduled, additional plants cannot be added to that specific appointment. We'd be delighted to return at a later date for any additional planting needs (additional fees may apply).
- **Day-of Notification:** On the day of your appointment, our planting crew will contact you via text to provide a window for their anticipated arrival.

Disclaimer: Please note that while we strive to arrive within the 2-hour window provided on the day of your appointment, unforeseen circumstances such as traffic or weather conditions may cause delays. We appreciate your understanding and patience should any adjustments to the schedule be necessary.

Removal of Failed Plants

If an existing tree or shrub in your planting area needs removed, please notify us. We offer professional removal services at a rate of \$75/hour. To cover disposal expenses, any work done under one hour will incur the base charge of one hour (\$75). If you purchase a plant from us that fails within our one-year return opportunity, the removal of the failed plant is not subject to this charge.

Important Note: Our team can safely remove trees up to 3" caliper. For larger trees, stump grinding is necessary, and new trees must be planted at least 5' away. To replace a tree in the same location, the root ball must be fully removed or have been ground out at least 6 months prior. If you are in need of stump grinding for larger trees, we recommend Rick at All Metro Stump Removal. You can reach him at 720-495-1481.

Note: Please ensure that your tree is ground out before scheduling any planting services with us to facilitate a smooth process.

Cancellation Policy

We understand that plans can change! To ensure smooth scheduling for all our clients, we kindly ask for at least 72 hours' notice for any cancellations. If you need to cancel your planting appointment or specific plants. This helps us manage our resources effectively and continue providing exceptional service to all our customers. Thank you for your understanding!

HOA Requirements

Many Homeowners Associations (HOAs) have specific guidelines for tree planting and replacement, including approved species and size requirements. Since some HOAs are more flexible than others, we strongly encourage you to check with your HOA before scheduling your planting service to ensure compliance. We are not responsible for any plantings done without HOA approval.

Our Return Opportunity

At Tagawa Gardens, we stand behind our work.

- **One-Year Return Opportunity:** All **trees, shrubs, and perennials** purchased from us come with a one-time, one-year return opportunity for in-store credit based on the purchase price, regardless of who plants them. Please note that replacement trees, shrubs, and perennials purchased with store credit are not eligible for return opportunity.
 - **Service Guarantee:** If we plant your **trees, shrubs, or perennials** and they fail, we will replant your plant purchased with your store credit at no additional charge. For larger replacements, an additional planting fee may apply. The replacement tree must be planted in the same location as the failed tree; an additional fee of 50% of the original planting cost for that tree size will apply if the replacement tree is relocated. Please note that this guarantee is not transferable. Additionally, there is no service guarantee for trees and shrubs that have been damaged or destroyed by deer or dogs, or power equipment. In such cases, the replanting will be charged at regular price. Please note that replacement trees, shrubs, and perennials purchased with store credit are not eligible for service guarantee.
